The Women of Grace Center houses up to 15 women ages eighteen years (18) and up. To be admitted a candidate must first contact our administrator and follow admission guidelines to assure a successful entry. The Women of Grace recovery program provides the ladies a home-like environment while focusing on their relationship with Jesus Christ. During the same time, they are trained in areas such as vocation, work ethic, child-rearing, and financial stewardship.
